REV Theatre Company brings fresh, contemporary vision to existing dramatic works and company created musical pieces. We present our work in unique and site-specific places – the steps of the Philadelphia Art Museum, parking lots in Philadelphia and New York, a Hudson River Pier, NYC's Lower East Side storefronts, the grounds of a Cape May Victorian mansion, historic, iconic Philadelphia cemeteries and dozens of Tri-State area parks. These outdoor productions also enable REV to engage with diverse communities in Philadelphia, New York City, Scranton, throughout Connecticut and in upstate New York.

REV's Shakespeare productions (*Hamlet*, *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, *The Comedy of Errors*, *Othello*...) and original Philadelphia Fringe musical pieces (*Death Is A Cabaret*, *Ol' Chum: The Graveyard Cabaret*, *REV's 1940s Canteen*, *REV's Vaudeville*, *REV's Lil' Ol' Rodeo Show*) have all been consistently critically acclaimed and have reached well over thirteen thousand people, including the good citizens of Scranton. We take our work to veterans, nursing homes, and shelters too. Educational outreach and senior programs are also an essential and extensive part of REV's mission. This is REV's twenty third performance/production program in Scranton.
